
# **Family Tree**

Your educational level? Began attending high school in Jihlava, did not finish school.

#### What sort of work do/did you do?

Because after the war I didn't have an education nor money, I had to work as a servant. I babysat children, cleaned and cooked. After my sons were born I was a housewife and later went on disability pension.

#### How religious was your parents' home? How were you raised?

We didn't observe Jewish traditions very much in our household. Just at Passover there was some sort of seder, and for Chanukkah we lit candles. At Christmas we had a Christmas tree. We didn't practice traditional Judaism, but we were aware of the fact that we were Jews. My father was very benevolent when it came to questions of faith and nationality. I think that despite this he felt himself to be mainly a Jew, but he didn't differentiate people. He didn't care if they were Germans, Czechs or Jews. What is your mother tongue? German
