

- 1. Roza: married, housewife, had 7 sons and one daughter children, lived in Munkacs, husband, called Weinberger, was the owner of the mikve of the town, almost the whole family was deported to Auschwitz and the daughter and two or three sons survived only.
- 2. Frida:married, housewife, one son, her husband owned a fruitshop, lived in Satoraljaujhely, killed in Auschwitz
- 3. Etel: lived in Nyiregyhaza, married Grunberger, they had a fruit and vegetable shop, had no children, killed in Auschwitz
- 4. Cili:lived in Nyiregyhaza, helped in Etel's shop
- 5. Sandor: married, lived in Beregszasz, killed in Auschwitz
- 6. Fancsi: lived in Kisvarad, housewife, had many children, killed in Auschwitz
- 7. Geza: lived in Munkacs with his father, merchant, had two daughters, killed in the Holocaust
- 8. Hugo: born in 1901, merchant, partner in my father's business, lived in Nyiregyhaza after the war and worked in the same brach of business after the nationalizations, married in 1947, died in Budapest in the 1970s
- 9. Milli lived in the US, no more information
- 10. a twin brother of my father lived in the US, no more information

- 3. Sie was divorced and lived with his mother and two siblings, had a daughter from his marriage who lived in Budapest, survived the war and then emigrated to the US, became very religious and worked in high positions, even in the Whie House in Washington.
- 4. Adolf lived in Nyiregyhaza, had a porcelaine and glass shop, had three marriages and three sons, only one called Jozsef survived, he left for Israel after the war.
- 5. Lenke had three children and became widowed at age 24, lived in Nagyszollos, was deported from there and all the family was murdered.
- 6. a brother went to the US and had a restaurant, no more information.
- 7. Kati had a husband and a son called Jeno, lived first in Munkacs, then in Pozsony, she was in hiding in Budapest during the war, her son and husband were deported but all three of them survived the war.
