
Family Tree

I was a typist before the war, and a cashier after the war. I was a housewife most of the time.

My parents were religious, Father was more religious than Mother. He went to the synagogue on Saturdays, observed traditions and celebrated holidays.

What is your mother tongue?

Yiddish

What other languages do you speak?

Russian, Lithuanian

Evacuation in Kargaly (today Kazakhstan)

What did you do after the Holocaust?

Came back to Lithuania, lived in Kaunas, bore and raised a son, worked and took care of the household.
