

Henrich Perlman (m): Saldus, before 1901 – Moscow, 1958; engineer. Lived in Moscow after the war, his wife and two children died during the Holocaust. Observed Jewish traditions.

Benno Perlman (m): Saldus, before 1901 – Riga ghetto, 1942; entrepreneur, married, 2 children, all perished in the ghetto. Observed Jewish traditions.
Zvi Perlman (m): Saldus, before 1901 - ?; moved to Africa with his family in the

1930s.
