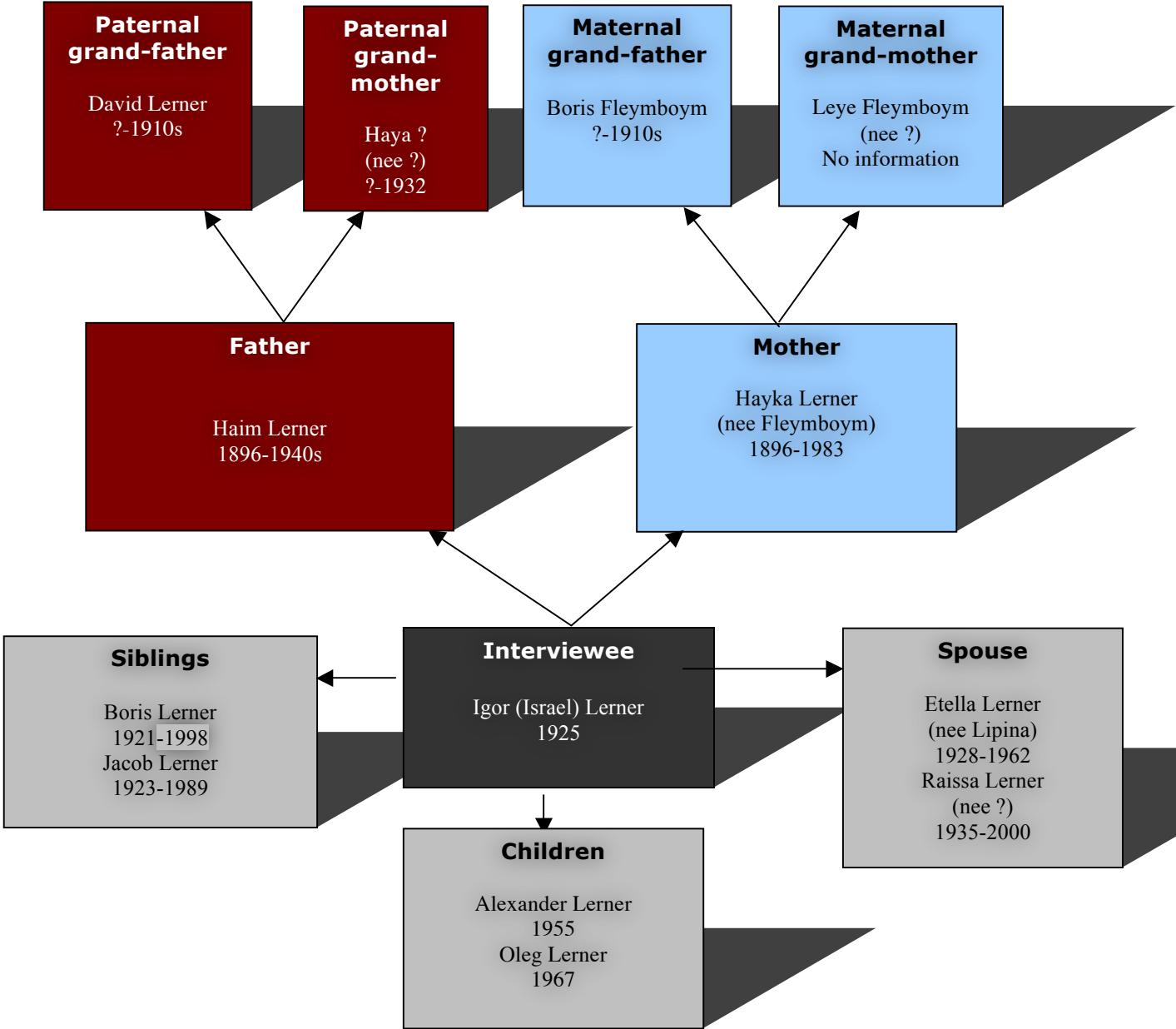

She was religious: observed kashrut and prayed. She got married under chuppah and kept 2 thick prayer books (in Hebrew) till her death. All her life long Mom celebrated Sabbath, made matzot herself (when it was not possible to be bought). I remember that we moved to Leningrad on Saturday, and not all her belongings had been transported: Mom's candlesticks were absent. She cut a potato in two and attached candles to the halves. At home we celebrated all Jewish holidays. We observed strict kosher.
