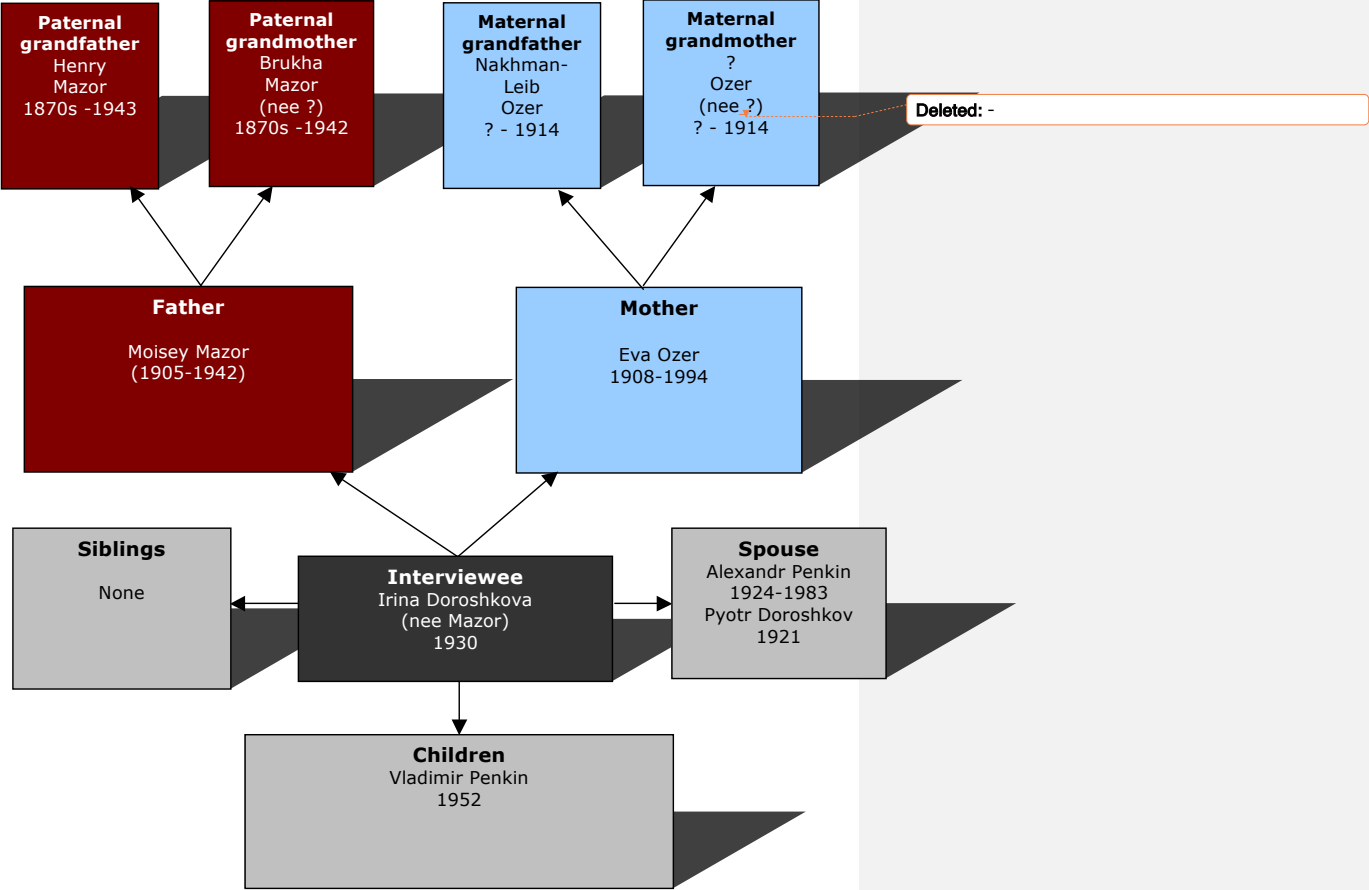

1. **Joseph Mazor** 1902 p. Berdichev, lived in Odessa, wife Manya Koifman, daughter Tsylia. Perished at the front in 1941.
2. **Sarah Mazor** 1903. Berdichev, lived in Kiev, perished in the Babiy Yar with her three children in 1941. Her husband perished at the front.
3. **Rieva Mazor** 1906, Berdichev, lived in Kiev before the war and after the war - in Berdichev, died in 1994, daughter Irina.
4. **Leo Mazor** 1908. Berdichev, beekeeper, died in 1978; wife and daughter passed away.
5. **Lessia Mazor** 1912, Single, perished at the front in 1943.

1. **Reizel (Rosa) Lieberson** (nee Ozer) 1898, Berdichev, lived in Odessa before the war, cook, husband – shoemaker, two sons perished during the

Great Patriotic War, after the war lived in Berdichev, Tiraspol with her daughter Maria. Died in 1983.

2. **Leizer Ozer** 1900. Berdichev, slaughterer at the butcher's factory, married, three daughters. Died in Berdichev in 1985.
3. **David Ozer** 1910 Berdichev, veterinary, two children. Died in Berdichev in 1989.
4. **Teibl (Tania) Ozer** 1912. Berdichev. Vanished in 1920, no further information.
