


The Ketubbah Of Ilona And Laszlo Czitrom



This is the ketubbah of my parents, Laszlo Czitrom and Ilona Czitrom, nee Fischer, issued in 1932. My father was born in August 1901. He probably graduated from some kind of industrial school. He learnt the mechanic or locksmith trade. Perhaps he didn't even want to study, though he taught himself a lot; I saw lots of books on mechanics and other subjects in his home after the war. He took different jobs: anything from mechanic to locksmith jobs. I know that during the war, he worked in the petroleum factory. My mother was an only child. Her mother was Irma Schwartz, born in 1883, and her father was Mihaly Fischer, born in 1880. Both of them were from Gyoma. My



mother was born in Gyoma in 1905, but only because her mother went home to have the baby - they already lived in Ujpest at that time. My grandfather was already dead at the time of mother's engagement, back in 1931.
