Sitting on the left is Uncle Vilem Vohryzek, the husband of my mother's sister Bedriská, then my father's brother Josef Munk, Aunt Bedriská Munková, at the head of the table my mother Olga Munková (nee Nachodová), my father Adolf Munk, then Mr. Janovic, his wife, my mother's father Rudolf Nachod, Aunt Elsa Edererová (nee Nachodová), my mother's sister.

The Janovics were friends. I don't remember them very much. I only know that they were relatively rich. They had an oil plant in Brandys. They had a daughter, Ida, who somehow married badly. Ida had a daughter, Eva, who was in Terezin and returned. Ida most likely died still before the war.
