That women's string orchestra was gathered from three theaters, which had a big orchestra: the Sofia People's Opera House, the State Musical Theater and the Youth Theater in the capital. We regularly performed in the famous concert hall 'Bulgaria' in the center of Sofia. We had our regular audience. We were proud of having people who admired us.
