CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION AS AN AUSTRALIAN CITIZEN.


WHEREAS THOMAS MOLNAR
has applied for a Certificate of Naturalization as an Australian Citizen, alleging with respect to himself the particulars set out on the reverse side hereof, and has satisfied me that he has fulfilled the conditions laid down in the *Nationality and Citizenship Act 1948-1953* for the grant of such a Certificate:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Minister of State for Immigration, hereby grant, in pursuance of the *Nationality and Citizenship Act 1948-1953* this Certificate of Naturalization, whereby, subject to the provisions of the said Act and of any other law affecting the rights of naturalized persons, the said

THOMAS MOLNAR

shall, as from the date upon which he swears or affirms allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, her heirs and successors, and swears to, or affirms that he will, observe faithfully the laws of Australia and fulfil his duties as an Australian citizen, become entitled to all political and other rights, powers and privileges, and become subject to all obligations, duties and liabilities to which an Australian citizen or a British subject is entitled or subject, and have to all intents and purposes the status of an Australian citizen and British subject.
