My aunt Kato [my father's sister] visiting in Budapest. My father, Imre, was born in 1901, and auntie Kato in 1907. Her husband was an engineer and worked in the Tungsram Electric Company. He died in forced labor. Kato came back and she lived with us too. [After the war] Auntie Kato worked at the Publishing Company. She remarried and she has children. She left Hungary in 1965. She's still alive and she lives in Paris and is 94 years old.
