

Military

What was his level of religiosity?

Not religious

What was his mother tongue?

Russian

Army service: Which army and what years?

1924-1926: military service

1938-1941: personnel service in the Red Army

Tell me about his brothers and sisters. (name, date of birth and death, occupation, place of residence, family, etc.)

Brother Mordukh: lived in Rogachyov, worked in a store, wife died in evacuation, five children:

Senya (m) – war veteran, disabled, now lives in America

Mulya (m) – perished at the frontline

Fadey (m) – lives in Israel now, works as a machine-operator

Mark (m) – construction designer, died of a stroke

Nina (f) – housewife

Sister Chesya: confectioner, did not leave for evacuation, executed by shooting in Dnepropetrovsk in 1941

Sister Basya: was evacuated, survived the war. Three children: elder daughter Rosa is a nurse, worked in a hospital. Younger daughter Anna (15 years old) and son Boris (17 years old) ran away to the frontline without permission of the parents and disappeared without a trace

1941: at the front, reported missing in action

Afroim (m): 1914, workshop manager, Rogachyov, Leningrad, died in Israel (date unknown)

Pavel (m): 1910, workshop manager, Rogachyov, Leningrad, died in Leningrad (1990s)

Semyon (m): 1905, workshop manager, Rogachyov, Leningrad, died in Leningrad (date unknown)

Revekka (f): 1907, Rogachyov, Leningrad, accountant, died in Leningrad (date unknown)

Serafima (f): 1902, executed by shooting in 1941, Rogachyov, Leningrad, accountant, shot by Germans in 1941. Two daughters, Zinaida and Ninel

Where was she during the Holocaust?

In evacuation: Sverdlovsk region, Khudyakovo station, Zaikovo village

If she survived, what did she do after?

Worked as a waitress in a canteen

Your mother's father's name?

Meilakh Goldin

Where and when was he born?

Rogachyov (today Belarus), 1880s

Lugansk (today Ukraine)

Home education - was literate
