What sort of education did she have? Jewish school, four years

What sort of work did she do? Head of day nursery, municipal hospital matron, Nevel

What was her level of religiosity?

Was raised in a religious family, had a wedding with a chuppah, according to Jewish traditions. Son was circumcised. Later being a Soviet active worker concealed her religiosity and did not observe Jewish traditions. In the 1960s-1970s (in Leningrad) prayed a lot and her daughter with her husband took her to the synagogue.

What was her mother tongue? Yiddish *Tell me about her brothers and sisters. (name, date of birth and death, occupation, place of residence, family, etc.)*

Chaim (1888-1943): lived in Rybinsk, wife Tesya, daughter Minna. Was an Orthodox Jew, observed all Jewish traditions, prayed regularly when he visited his relatives in Nevel. He died during the war, his family survived.

Isaih (1897-1951): farmer, lived in Leningrad before the war, wife Zhenya, son Sima. Was in evacuation in Kazan. Returned to Leningrad. Died at the age of 54. Mendel (1902-1973): lived in Nevel, printer, graduated from Smolensk Medical Institute at the age of 40. Surgeon at the front during the war. Returned to Nevel, got married. Wife Malka (physician), daughter Natalia, 1950, teacher of English. Her husband works at a sewing factory.

Where was she during the Holocaust?

1941: ghetto, Nevel

1941-1942: on occupied territory, Ostrov

1942: guerilla troops in Leningrad region

1942-1945: in evacuation, Kazan

If she survived, what did she do after? 1945-1952: matron at the Nevel municipal hospital 1952-1976: lived with daughter Sofia in Leningrad Your mother's father 's name? Iosif Gendel (Jewish name: Ysef Leisar)
