*5 Recorded narrative – crisp, audible, DO NOT DROWN WITH MUSIC		25
*6 Visuals Include maps, documents if have them, photographs. You must use internet visuals if you don't have family stuff. Choose visuals of the time period		25
7 Interview (optional) You may make an interview, either with the actual subject or another family member.		
*8 Choose Music Music needs to fit the theme. Use copyright free music if you want to publish this. DON'T DROWN NARRATIVE		15
9 One or Two Quotations Use a text box for this.		
*10 Introduction and Conclusion (reflection) The movie needs to have a beginning, middle and end. Besides a clear end you need a short reflection.		20
*11 Well produced, no obvious errors or gaffes, no typos. Meets deadlines. Ready for showtime.		20
