## **HINWEISE FÜR DIE ARBEIT MIT DEM UNTERRICHTSENTWURF**

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### **Pre-watching activities**

The students discuss in groups and take some notes about the impact of history on their lives, share aspects of their family history and the origin of their relatives (see Material).

### **After watching the movie**

The students reflect upon the film and discuss questions in class (see Material).

### **Short comment**

Students write a short comment about „Laszlo Nussbaum“ including their own impressions and opinion (120 words).

### **Wrap-up**

Students discuss in class and together create ideas for a map on a large sheet of paper that shows all their roots – for example in lines or in colours.

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### **Working input: Pre-watching activites**

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Do you have relatives in other countries? Where do they come from?

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How is your relationship with them?

## **ARBEITSIMPULS**

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**Working input:** After watching the movie:

Discuss the following questions in class:

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What was the most interesting aspect for you in this film?

What do you think about combining old fashioned story-telling with modern technology?

What is your answer to the following questions:

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Do you think that these kinds of movies are able to arouse interest in young people? Can you imagine producing a similar movie or another one for students or young people?

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### **Working input: Short comment**

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Write a short comment about the film „Laszlo Nussbaum“ including your own impressions and your opinion (120 words).

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### **Working input: Wrap up**
