

**Emmanuil (Monia) Baru**, 1902 – 1943, Novorossiysk, doctor, single, no children, director of hospital during the war, perished in battle in the vicinity of Moscow;

**Sophia Baru**, Vetman in marriage, 1900 – 1942, housewife, Kiev, two sons, one was an English teacher, perished on the front in 1941, and Boris Vetman, journalist, lived in Odessa, immigrated to Israel.
