

1. **Revekka Sokol (nee – Schwartz)** 1894-1964 – roentgenologist, lived and died in Kharkov, son Alik perished before the war
2. **David Schwartz** 1896-1937 – military chemical engineer, perished during the period of repression, his wife and daughter were shot by Germans in Taganrog in 1942
3. **Isaac Schwartz** 1900-1915- died in infantry

At the front, Russia, Ukraine

Lived in Lvov, worked at Lvov coal trust

1. **Liya Lutrovnik** (1882-1965) – single, graduated from Sorbonne University, doctor, worked in Evpatoria, evacuation, lived in Balashykhina after the war
2. **Sophia Deitorovich** (nee – Lutrovnik) (1885-1919) - finished grammar school, lived with her husband in Odessa, Voznesensk, daughter Irina
3. **Anna Deitorovich** (nee – Lutrovnik) – 1889-1954 – studied in Paris after finishing grammar school, didn't finish the Sorbonne University due to the war. Married Mark Deitorovich after her older sister Sophia passed away, raised her daughter. Lived in Voznesensk and Moscow.

Lived in Lvov with her daughter Clara and her granddaughter

1. **Sophia Grigorenko (nee-Doctorovich)** – 1892-1980s, lived in Evpatoria, cook, four children: Nikolay, Michael, Valentina, evacuation [in WWI](#)

2. **Evgenia Shulkina (nee-Doctorovich)** – 1896 – 1960s – married to Khaim Shulkin, revolutionary and Komsomol member that was shot during the civil war in Evpatoria, no children of their own, raised her sister's daughter
3. No information about the rest of sisters and brothers

*Where was she during the Holocaust?*

Evacuation in Udobnaya, Sovietskaya villages of Krasnodar region, in 1942 this village was occupied by fascists for 6 months

*If she survived, what did she do after?*

Lived in Lvov with her husband and daughter, housewife
