

Maria (1885-1920) finished school. Died young from typhus
Samuel (1890-1970s) was in the evacuation. After the war he lived in the vicinity of Moscow, died in early 70s.

Rosa (1893-1943) and her husband lived in Zvenigorodka, had no children, was shot by the fascists

Efim (1894-1939) was Chairman of the collective farm and had two daughters
Vladimir (1896-1941) lived in Kharkov, He, his wife, his son and his grandson were shot by the fascists
