

She wasn't religious. She didn't go to synagogue. She celebrated Sabbath and Jewish holidays, followed kashrut and wore a kerchief, but she did it for the sake of her father. She observed Jewish traditions after her father died through the time when her mother – grandmother Enta was with us. Later mother didn't do anything in this regard
