Where else did you live? Marosheviz, Gyergyoszentmiklos, Marosvasarhely (Romania)

Your educational level?

Eight years of gymnasium in a French institute, certificate of final examination and piano teacher qualification, Marosvasarhely (today Targu Mures)

What sort of work do/did you do? Before WWII: housewife After WWII: cashier for a short time, then housewife

#### How religious was your parents' home? How were you raised?

I wasn't kosher: I ate here, I ate there, but I observed some of the traditions. I light two candles on Friday evening even today. I put a shawl on my head, and there is a prayer we recite in Hebrew, I know that by heart. I kept a kosher household until 1940, until it was possible.

What is your mother tongue? Hungarian

What other languages do you speak? Romanian, German, French Where were you during the Holocaust? Concentration camp: Auschwitz-Birkenau (Poland) Concentration camp: Bergen-Belsen (Germany) Labor camp: Leipzig (in an aircraft factory) (Germany)

What did you do after the Holocaust? I was a housewife.

Cashier in Szeged (for more than 1 year), cashier in Gyergyovarhegy in a Romanian-Swiss timber mill, then became office-holder and technical manager of the factory.

He worked on Saturdays, and he even traveled and wrote, if he had to, what an Orthodox would not be allowed to. But we had no pork in the house.
