

Non-religious, atheist

*What was her mother tongue?*

Russian

Evsei: 1911-1942, died during the blockade of Leningrad

Semen: 1912-1937, Leningrad, subjected to repressions when he was a student of the university. Rehabilitated posthumously.

Zinaida: 1910-1994, tutor in a kindergarten, married, 2 children, 1 son died in evacuation.

Yakov: 1914-1991, worker, Leningrad, married, 1 child

Lyubov: 1915, telegraph operator, Leningrad, married, 1 child

Grigory: 1924-1942, student, died in the blockade of Leningrad
