



- explore the unique history of Berlin and Hamburg and tour historical sites, including excursions to the Holocaust Memorial, Russian-German Museum, Soviet War Memorial Treptow, Berlin Wall Memorial, Memorial site of KZ Neuengamme and other sites;
- meet renowned German journalists and politicians to discuss German Holocaust remembrance culture;
- develop German-Israeli school projects using Centropa's short films and biographies of German-Jewish Holocaust survivors;
- present their project results in a final online presentation, "The city as a classroom: 20th century European Jewish history and the Holocaust", at the end of 2021.
