Assignment Overview for Students

PREPARING FOR THE INTERVIEW

- Take your cell phone with you to record the interview. Also, take another cell phone or camera so that you can take pictures of your relative while s/he is cooking.
- Take pictures of your relative cooking the food.

SUGGESTED INTERVIEWER'S QUESTIONS THE ORIGINS OF YOUR FAMILY

- 1. Where did your great-grandparents or great-great grandparents come from?
- 2. What did they do for a living?
- 3. How religious they were?
- 4. What languages did they speak, and what did they speak with each other?
- 5. What clothes did they wear?
- 6. What did their house/apartment look like?
- 7. What relationship did they have with their neighbors?

RECIPES

- 1. Choose a holiday and describe one specific food that your family ate
- 2. When did your family eat this food?
- 3. What memories does your relative have about this food?
- 4. Who made this food?
- 5. Who in your family makes this food now for the holiday?
- 6. Has the recipe changed?
- 7. Why does your family make this food during the holiday?

WHAT TO DO AFTER THE INTERVIEW

- Use about 10 slides in your power point presentation
- Include the entire recipe on one slide
- Include your family tree on one slide
- Include music
- You may include parts of the actual oral interview or you can type captions on each slide

 - 1. Find one recipe that is similar to yours from the site (look on the left and right side of the page)
 - 2. Choose one recipe and click on it. You will find the recipe and scroll down to a story about the recipe.

 - 4. Include the following:
 - a. Name of the food
 - b. Where it came from

- c. When is it eaten
- d. Why you chose this recipe (Explain how it is similar to your recipe)
