

My family was very religious. We observed Jewish traditions, celebrated all Jewish holidays and followed the kashrut. On high holidays the shop was closed, and we went to the temple. My parents fasted on Yom Kippur. Every Friday and Sabbath kiddush was said over a glass of wine and candles were lit.
