


**Family Tree**

Parents were rather religious, mother wore a wig, father went to the synagogue on holidays, they observed traditions and marked holidays

*What is your mother tongue?*

Yiddish

Lithuanian, Russian, Ivrit, German

Soviet Army, front since February 1942 till February 1947

*Where were you during the Holocaust?*

Evacuation in kolkhoz named after Voroshylov, Novosibirsk oblast, then acting army: Russia, Belarus, Poland, Germany

*What did you do after the Holocaust?*

Came back in Plunge, worked, got married, raised 3 sons, painted and worked on perpetuation of the perished Jews
