


Family Tree

In the 1960s worked in a car service, then as a clerk at a lottery agency, retired in 1970

How religious was your parents' home? How were you raised?

My parents' home was not religious. My parents observed the Jewish traditions, as well as all the high holidays, but were not strict observers. I was educated in this spirit.

What is your mother tongue?

Romanian

What other languages do you speak?

Yiddish and German

Where were you during the Holocaust?

On not occupied territory: Bacau, Ploiesti

Moved with the husband and daughter to Constanta, then to Bucharest

How religious was he?

He was not very religious. He had religious wedding ceremony, observed high holidays and traditions, went to the Temple on that occasion, ate kosher at home, but not when dining out.

What was his mother tongue?

Yiddish and Romanian

Enrolled in the Romanian army during WWI, in 1916

Bacau, 1941 (committed suicide on the day Romania joined WWII)

Some Jewish education, knew Hebrew

What sort of work did he do?

Land owner in Bacau county and owner of a restaurant in Bacau

How religious was he?

He was very religious, strict observer of the Jewish traditions, but wore modern clothes. He was the leader of the Jewish community in Bacau for a period.
