

Nagyvarad (1926/7–1943), Alsoszipor (1943–1946); Nagyvarad (1946–1948); Rev (ca. 1 year); Bratka (?); Borsabanya (8 months); Borpatak (6 months); Gyulafehervar (6 years); Stej (2 years); Rimnicu Vilcea (11 years); Marosvasarhely (since 1973)

Your educational level?

High school graduation before the war, stenography and typist course after WWII, Nagyvarad

What sort of work do/did you do?

Housewife

How religious was your parents' home? How were you raised?

The mother only observed the traditions and had a kosher household due to her parents, especially her father. Anna Gaspar is not religious at all, not even while she was a child. She was always quarrelling with her grandfather.

She was not raised Jewish, but she considers herself Jewish. From time to time she goes to the Jewish Community for drugs for her mother or to attend different events, Seder eve, the service at Chanukkah.

Not religious at all, not used to wear a hat. He didn't observe the traditions. He ate bacon and sour cream with meat.

What was his mother tongue?

Hungarian

Officer in the Austro-Hungarian army, fought in WWI, and received a decoration.

He was an Orthodox Jew, strictly observed the prescriptions. Observed Sabbath, Pesach, and every holiday. He prayed each morning with kippah on his head, tallit and tefillin on his arms. He prayed each morning. He had the Talmud a lot. He conducted the Seder eve for the whole family.
