

My parents were very religious, they were Orthodox. My mother kept a kosher kitchen. We used separate dishes for Pesach. My father went to the synagogue every week – every Friday evening and Saturday. On Friday evenings my mother used to light candles – one for each member of the family, and my father cut the challah.

Hungarian
