twin brother Mark (1906-1961): engineer/metallurgist. Before the war he lived in Pushkin,

junior research assistant at the defense institute NII-13.

Chana (married name-Blyomkina) (1900-1941) with her husband and son Alexander perished during the Holocaust, in Starodub.

Samuel: with his wife and two children perished during the Holocaust, in

Starodub.

Chaya: had epilepsy, and was disabled.

In the evacuation in Nizhny Tagul, in Sverslovskoy oblast; worked in the branch of Gypromez, building blast furnaces, then restored the rolling mills in Yshorskoy factory (in Kolpino, in Leningrad oblast).

Brother Mark: injured in WWII; became an invalid unable to move; worked as head engineer at the Scheleshnoy Trust in Leningrad, then as designer at the Gyprocpetzgaz (Design Institute of the Gas Industry). Mark and Adolf: married in the beginning of the 1930's to sisters (née Shapiro) – Fanny and Mary, from Zaporozsh. Adolf and Mary had daughter Irma (married name Kozub) in 1932, and Asya, in 1948. They are currently living Petersburg.

Graduated from secondary school, then from agricultural technical school, specializing in agricultural techniques.

What sort of work did she do?

Before the war: She worked raising livestock, in agriculture, and in the laboratory at the Soil Sciences and Horticulture department at Leningrad Agricultural Institute (LSHI) After the war: she worked in the VIAM microbiology department, where she took part in cultivating vaccines against whooping-cough and diphtheria.

What was her level of religiosity? Non-religious

What was her mother tongue? Yiddish

1 brother and 2 sisters: Zinovi (Zalman), Sonya, Liza

Zinovi (Zalman) (1900-1981): chairman of the Jewish collective farm in Starodub; after the war worked in the financial department of the Orlovskoy oblast agricultural administration. Sonya: married to Avrahm Levant, and worked on a collective farm. Sonya, her husband and their children Lenya and Raya perished in Starodub at the beginning of 1942 in the camp/ghetto. Liza: (married name Sheifrina): married to the director of a grocery store; lived in Klintz, Bryanskoy oblast, killed by the Germans together with their daughter Raya in 1941
