

1) Yosef Blinderman: born in 1910 in the village Buki. Until the war he
studied in a Party university of Dnepropetrovsk. He was a commissar in
the war and was killed on the front in 1941.
the war and was kined on the Hollt III 1941.

- 2) Efim Blinderman (1912-1995) a worker; lived in the city Balashove of the Saratovskaya region. 1941-1944 he fought on the front and was wounded.
- 3) Fira Blinderman (1908 1994). She worked as an accountant in Mariupol. After her husband was killed during battle she lived with her mother and daughter. During the evacuation she was in Aktiubinsk, from which she returned to Mariupol, Ukraine in 1945.
- 4) Klara Blinderman (1918-1996). She completed secondary education and worked as a laboratory assistant for the enterprise Azovstal'. Having never married, she lived in the family of her sister, Anna Blinderman for 23 years (1939-1962).

The fourth one, Moisha was wounded but she nursed him back to health. The rest of her brothers emigrated to the US in 1919 and her sister to Palestine, also in 1919.
