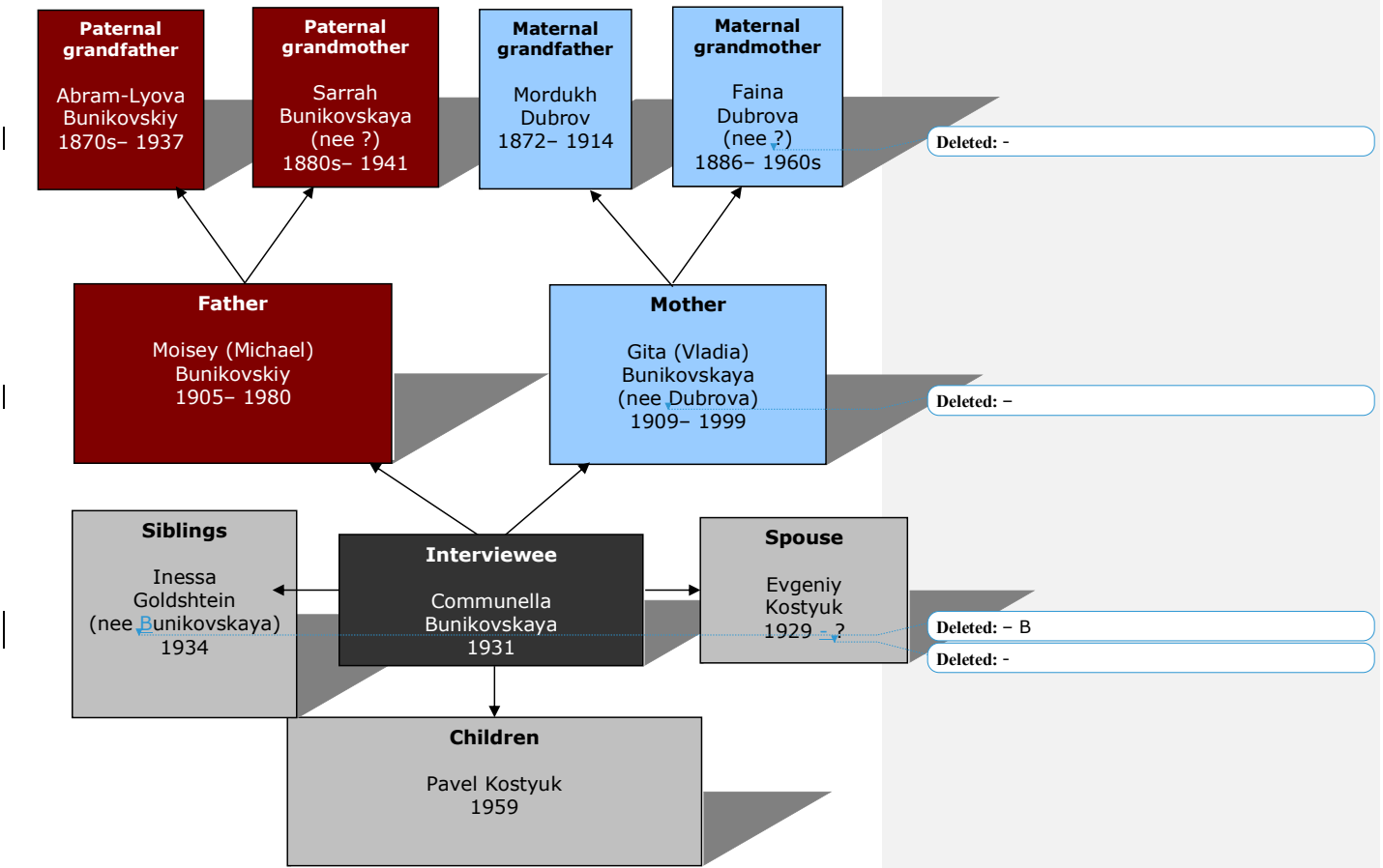

Alexandra, 1908– 1990s, born and lived in Donetsk, housewife, husband (Turlianskiy), children: Murah, Semyon, Kostantin

Anna, 1911– 2001, born in Yuzovka, graduated from Institute of Physical culture, trainer in calisthenics, lived in Dnepropetrovsk, married, son Mark

Clara, 1913– 1980s, born and lived in Donetsk, typist and stenographer at Donetsk Regional party Committee, married, son Michael, daughter Larissa
