

Alexander, born in 1897 in Kholmichi, Belarus; after the war he lived in Donetsk; worked in provision departments; died in 1952 in Donetsk

Tsira (husband's last name – Israelit), date of birth unknown; lived in Leningrad; worked as a teacher; died in Moscow in 1950-s

ophthalmologist; interacted with Red Cross

Rebecca (husband's last name – Kagan), date of birth unknown; lived in Kharkov; worked as a dentist; died in 1950-s
