

Ella Lat (Kats), (1891 – 1940s): shop assistant, Riga, married, two children Rebecca and David, the whole family perished in the ghetto in Riga.

Tsylia Fridlinberg (Kats), (1890s - 1940s): housewife, Riga, married, two children Jacob and Rachel, the whole family perished in the ghetto in Riga **Nadia?** (Kats), (1890s – 1940s): housewife, Riga, married, five children, the whole family perished in the ghetto in Riga.

Mina ? (Kats), (1890s – 1961): housewife, Valka (Estonia), married, two children Eta, Khenach and Sholom During the war evacuated to Fergana. Eta lives in Israel since 1970s, Khenach and Sholom live in USA.

Slava ? (Kats), (1890s – 1941): shop assistant, Riga, married, one child, killed by Germans in Riga

Izia Kats, (1890s - 1941): owned a store, single, killed by Germans in RigaFrieda ? (Kats), (1901 - 1941): Riga, shop assistant, married, perished in Riga when German troops were coming into the town.

Dora ? (Videtskaya), (1883 – 1942): fabric cutter in a shop, Riga, married, four children Solomon, Ilia, Tsalel and Rebecca. All family killed in the ghetto in Riga.

Max Videtskiy (1885 – 1932): musician, Berlin, married, three children. His wife and children Walter and Ilsa perished during World War II.

Zhenia Medynch (Videtskaya), (1889 – 1942): housewife, Riga, married, two children Lyuba and Semyon. The whole family perished in the ghetto in Riga
