

All of my father's brothers were born in Soroki, Russia. All of them but Leon were in exile in Mogochino village, Krasnoyarsk region, since 1940. After they were released they stayed there. Their children also lived in this area. Leon and my father were sent in exile in Solikamsk, Molotov region, Siberia, in 1940. He stayed there after he was released and died there.

**Itzyk** Barzak, 1895 – 1942. Married, 6 children. Was sent to exile with his family. Before exile he owned a restaurant in Soroki. In1942 all members of his family perished.

**Meyer** Barzak, 1900 – 1980s. Married, his wife Ginda was in exile with him, 2 children – son Lyova, 1926, and daughter Bella, 1931. Before exile he owned a big shoe store.

**Leon** (Leib) Barzak, 1906 – 1966. Before exile he was my father's companion. His wife Liya stayed in Soroki, during the war she got married for the second time. Son Jacob born in 1933 lived with Liya. After 1948 he stayed in the settlement, worked as an accountant.

**Daniel** Barzak, 1908 – 1992. His wife Eva, and his son, born in 1934, were in exile with him. Eva died in 1882. Before exile he was an owner of a tavern

All of my mother's brothers and sisters were born in Yassy, Rumania. I have no information about the life of my mother's brothers after the war. We lost track of them.

**Yankel**, 1895 – ? Finished Yeshyva in Bucharest, was a gabba at the synagogue in Bucharest. Married, 3 children. I have no information about what happened to him after the war.

**Mark**, 1899 – ? finished a commercial school in Yassy. Owned a store. Married, two children.

**Shymon**, 1902 – ? Graduated from Medical University, worked as a doctor in Yassy. Married, 2 children.

**Fania**, 1904 – 1954, Israel. Married, her husband Matey Levizon was a manufacturer, they had two children. After the war they moved to Israel. I have no information about what happened to their children.

**Etia**, 1911 – 1942, Yassy. Got married in 1930. Shortly before the war she divorce he husband and returned to live with her mother. During the war she worked as a seamstress at the military garment factory in Yassy. Perished during an air raid in 1942.


