The tour begins with a sign that says, “costs for treatment by a Jewish doctor after April 1, 1933 will not be reimbursed by the City of Berlin's public health insurance company” and ends with “all files dealing with anti-Semitic activities are to be destroyed (February 16, 1945)”. Describe the changes that took place from 1933 to 1945 against the Jewish People.
2. Pick 2 of the 80 pictures of street art that stood out to you the most. Why did these stand out?
